

RAINER STEGMANN

Rainer Stegmann was Professor from 1982 to 1990 at the Institute of Environmental Protection and from 1991 to 2008 Head of the Institute of Waste Management at the Technical University of Hamburg, Germany. He retired in March 2008. He is one of the prominent researchers in the field of waste management and provided in particular fundamental scientific contributions on sustainable landfilling, anaerobic digestion, biogas generation and control, treatment of contaminated soil. He coordinated several international and national research projects, and was member of the environmental advisory board of Shanks. He co-founded and currently leads the 3RC Research Center at the Nanyang University, Singapore. He is co-organiser of several national and international conferences and has published more than 300 scientific papers and several books. Since 2008 he is the chairman of the IWWG (International Waste Working Group).
